Notice is given of the election audit required by the Lieutenant Governor's Election Policy. The Audit will be conducted during normal business hours in the County Courthouse 01 South Main Street #10, Brigham City, UT beginning Wednesday November 16, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. and continuing until completed. Anyone desiring to witness the audit is invited to attend.

Notice is given that on Tuesday November 22, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. at the Box Elder County Courthouse, Commission Chambers, 01 South Main Brigham City, Utah the Box Elder County Board of Canvassers will meet to canvass the returns and declare the results of the election.

QUALIFICATIONS TO VOTE

U.S. Citizen, resident of the State of Utah for over 30 days preceding election, 18 years of age by November 8, 2022, and registered to vote in Box Elder County.

You must present a valid form of identification to the poll workers at the time you vote in a Voting Assistance Center.
