Ballots will be mailed at least 45 days prior to the Election date. Ballots must be received by the County Clerk's Office no later than 8:00 pm Utah local time to be counted.

The state of Utah has a new electronic ballot delivery method. Electronic ballots, notices, and emails may come from Enhanced Voting ([enhancedballot.com](http://enhancedballot.com)).
